## Billions to phase-out coal? What about health care?

### Estimated cost of early coal phase-out:

~\$11 Billion industry compensation >\$11 Billion to build equivalent natural gas plant capacity.


#### **Estimated health benefit?**

Nominal to nothing. Cold and 'heat-or-eat' poverty due to **unaffordable power** are greater health risks.
