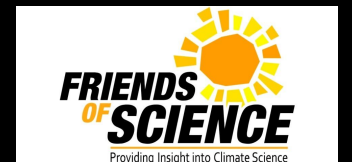




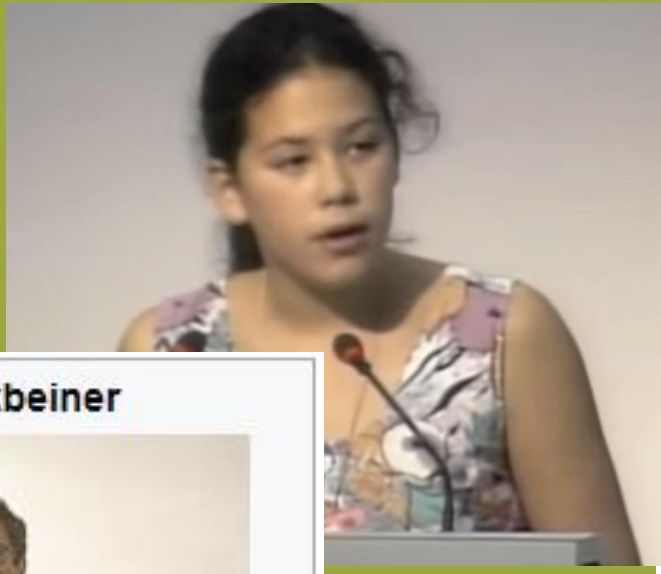

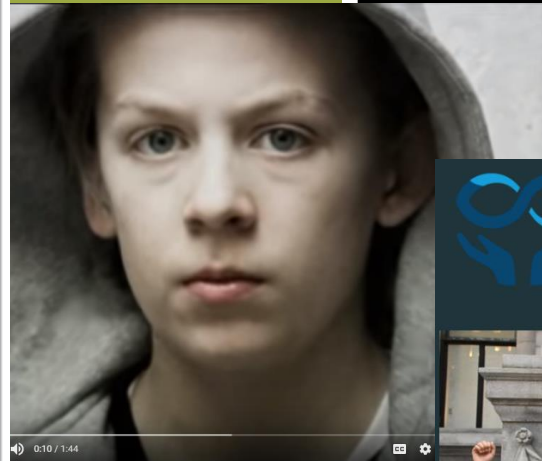

“ [W] here there is a legal right, there is also a legal remedy”<sup>1</sup> — unless there isn’t. “The remedial powers of an equity court . . . are not unlimited,”<sup>2</sup> and “traditional principles of equity jurisdiction” sometimes leave rightsholders without remedies for legal injuries.<sup>3</sup> Recently, in *Juliana v. United States*,<sup>4</sup> the Ninth Circuit held that ordering the federal government to adopt “a comprehensive scheme to decrease fossil fuel emissions and combat climate change” would exceed a federal court’s remedial authority.<sup>5</sup> The result in *Juliana* is not surprising. But *Juliana*’s reasoning, which suggests that “limited and precise” legal standards must always constrain a court in issuing equitable relief, subtly but significantly narrows the remedial capacity of courts adjudicating large-scale “structural reform” cases.<sup>6</sup>

## Toronto Climate Conference Calls for Sharp Cuts in Carbon Dioxide Emissions

The concluding statement of the World Conference on the Changing Atmosphere hosted June 27-30 in Toronto by the Canadian government called for a 20 percent cutback of global carbon dioxide emissions from current levels by 2005, and a phaseout of fully halogenated chlorofluorocarbons by 2000. This product resulted from four days of deliberations among over 300 policymakers, scientists, corporate and environmental leaders from 48 countries.

The conference statement also called for the creation of a World Atmosphere Fund to finance the development of technologies that will reduce greenhouse gas emissions. This resembled a proposal ad-

vanced in an Editorial in the Summer 1988 issue of *Climate Alert* (p. 2). The Fund would be financed largely through contributions from the industrialized countries although much of its focus would be on applications within the Third World. Despite the strong support for the creation of a World Atmosphere Fund, there was sharp disagreement among conference participants concerning the source

## NASA Scientist Testifies Greenhouse Warming Has Begun

Testifying before the Senate Committee on Energy and Natural Resources on June 23, Dr. James E. Hansen became the first prominent scientist to state that greenhouse warming is no longer a threat but a reality. Basing his assessment on the record of average global temperatures and on computer simulations of the probable influence of the greenhouse effect, Dr. Hansen of the Goddard Institute of Space Studies said he arrived at his conclusion "with a high degree of confidence."

The hearings were called, said Committee Chairman J. Bennett Johnston, to highlight the rapidity with which global climate change is entering the public and



Wirth served as a U.S. Senator from Colorado until 1993, when he left the Senate to serve under President Clinton in the State Department. He is now president of the [United Nations Foundation](#). Wirth organized the 1988 Senate hearing at which [James Hansen](#) addressed global warming, and he led the U.S. negotiating team at the Kyoto Summit. In this interview, Wirth describes the debate surrounding global warming within the Bush I and the Clinton administrations, including his experience of the Kyoto negotiations, and asserts that partisan politics, industry opposition and prominent skeptics have prevented action from being taken. This is an edited transcript of an interview conducted Jan. 17, 2007.

### How did you know about Jim Hansen?

... I don't remember exactly where the data came from, but we knew there was this scientist at NASA who had really identified the human impact before anybody else had done so and was very certain about it. So we called him up and asked him if he would testify. Now, this is a tough thing for a scientist to do when you're going to make such an outspoken statement as this and you're part of the federal bureaucracy. Jim Hansen has always been a very brave and outspoken individual.

### What else was happening that summer? What was the weather like that summer?

Believe it or not, we called the Weather Bureau and found out what historically was the hottest day of the summer. Well, it was June 6 or June 9 or whatever it was, so we scheduled the hearing that day, and bingo: It was the hottest day on record in Washington, or close to it. It was stiflingly hot that summer. [At] the same time you had this drought all across the country, so the linkage between the Hansen hearing and the drought became very intense.

Simultaneously [Mass. Gov. Michael] Dukakis was running for president. Dukakis was trying to get an edge on various things and was looking for spokespeople, and two or three of us became sort of the flacks out on the stump for Dukakis, making the separation between what Democratic policy and Republican policy ought to be. So it played into the presidential campaign in the summer of '88 as well.

So a number of things came together that, for the first time, people began to think about it. I knew it was important because there was a big article in, I believe, the Swimsuit Issue of *Sports Illustrated* on climate change. [Laughs.] So there was a correlation. You figure, well, if we're making *Sports Illustrated* on this issue, you know, we've got to be making some real headway.

### And did you also alter the temperature in the hearing room that day?

... What we did it was went in the night before and opened all the windows, I will admit, right? So that the air conditioning wasn't working inside the room and so when the, when the hearing occurred there was not only bliss, which is television cameras in double figures, but it was really hot. ...

So Hansen's giving this testimony, you've got these television cameras back there heating up the room, and the air conditioning in the room didn't appear to work. So it was sort of a perfect collection of events that happened that day, with the wonderful Jim Hansen, who was wiping his brow at the witness table and giving this remarkable testimony. ...

**The one thing that Hansen didn't do that day in front of your committee is use the term "global warming." He said, "Gentlemen, I'm 99 percent sure that human beings are contributing to climate change," but he didn't quite have the nerve, because he was outside scientific consensus at the time. ...**

Oh, Hansen went a long way. This was a very, very brave statement. He was on the edge of the science and almost 20 years younger than he is today, so he's relatively new in the field. He's working for the federal government, and certainly this was not cleared far up the line, what he had to say. So the summary of what Jim Hansen had to say that year, plus the fact that it had gotten so much attention from the [press] -- it was on every channel, Hansen was widely reported. He went as far as anybody could possibly have expected him to go, I think. Again, it was a very brave thing for him to do.

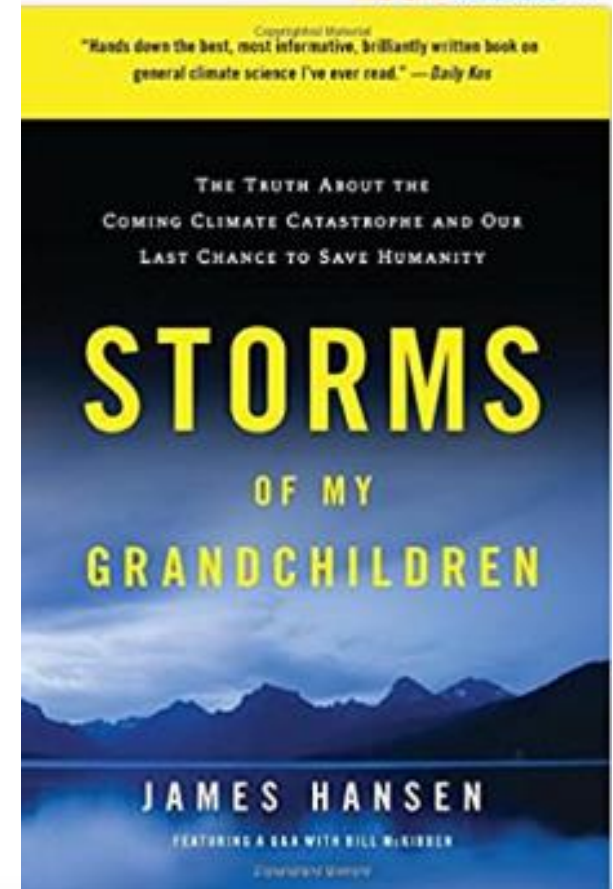

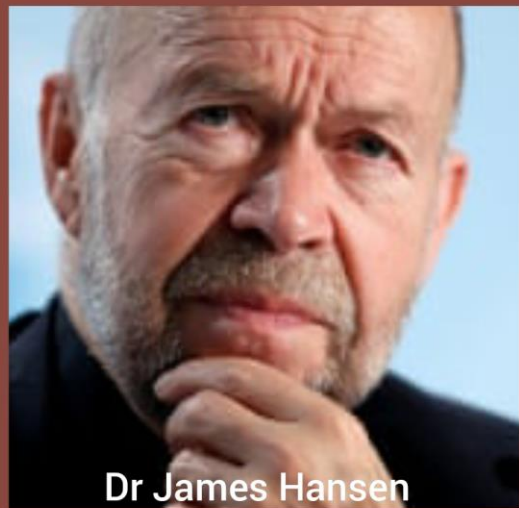



Whereas:

- Nine years ago, when her third daughter was born, Cathy Orlando vowed that she would do all she could to ensure that her children would grow up in a world safe from climate change. Orlando, who has a master's degree in science, did her homework. She found that many of the world's top climate scientists, including Dr. James Hansen, the NASA scientist who first told the U.S. Congress about the dangers of climate change in the late 1980s, agree that a critical step to control climate change would also be one of the simplest – putting a steadily rising price on carbon dioxide through a tax or fee on fossil fuels. The fee would make alternatives to fossil fuels cost-competitive, and spur investment and innovation in clean technology;

- Cathy Orlando, now the national manager of CCL Canada, leads a diverse range of citizens from coast to coast calling for effective government action that will leave our children a livable planet.

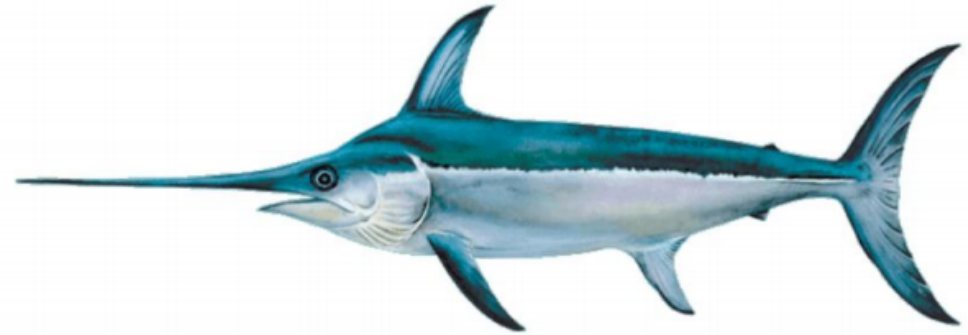

For more than a decade we have searched the world for a nation to demonstrate the one carbon pricing approach that would work: a rising carbon fee, collected from fossil fuel companies with the funds distributed uniformly, 100 percent, to the nation's citizens:

# Venus is a poor analogue to Earth.

Except for size and mass, Venus compares poorly with Earth in many aspects. Its current heat transfer and thermal evolution are disconnected from behavior on the Earth. **Venus with its 90 bar atmosphere is a poor analogue to Earth**, and its high temperatures do not show that ppm concentrations of CO<sub>2</sub> on Earth cause global warming. ...Given the opposite behavior of heat conduction in fluid and gassy states, **we propose that global warming on Earth is connected with Solar regulation of the ocean temperature, and the measured correlation of CO<sub>2</sub> with global temperature is due to a warmer ocean releasing more of its dissolved gases.**



## 18to8 campaign asks: Could lowering the voting age help save the planet?

Campaign suggests lowering voting age to eight would ensure climate change is a top priority for voters in October's federal election

VANCOUVER – Lowering the voting age from 18 to eight would make the climate emergency a top priority in the upcoming federal election, according to the 18to8 campaign.

Launched by the David Suzuki Foundation, the satirical campaign suggests that because today's children will be most affected by climate change, they are more aware of its scope and the urgency with which governments and citizens must act on solutions.

"Think lowering the voting age is crazy? Doing nothing is crazier," reads the campaign website. The campaign video includes scenes of kids organizing protests from 'campaign headquarters,' messages of support from several Canadian celebrities and a campaign jingle sung by Juno award-winning musician Dan Mangan.

"By suggesting eight-year-olds would vote with more wisdom than adults when it comes to prioritizing climate change, we are trying to playfully show that many adults simply are not giving climate change the attention it demands right now," David Suzuki Foundation CEO Stephen Cornish said.

# Foreign Funding. Blocking Pipelines, Jobs, Economy. Clogging Courts.

The origin of the US\$63,547 is not publicly reported, but Living Oceans spent that amount in 2016 on litigation to stop the Trans Mountain pipeline by intervening in its regulatory review and bringing judicial review proceedings.

“The Society worked with non-profit lawyers at Ecojustice to intervene in the regulatory review of the Kinder Morgan Trans Mountain pipeline and tanker project,” Living Oceans reported to the IRS.

Ecojustice is the entity that brought the application to the Federal Court of Appeal. Ecojustice is also funded to participate in the Tar Sands Campaign, and has been paid US\$815,000 (2009-2017) via San Francisco-based Tides Foundation for its participation in the Tar Sands Campaign.

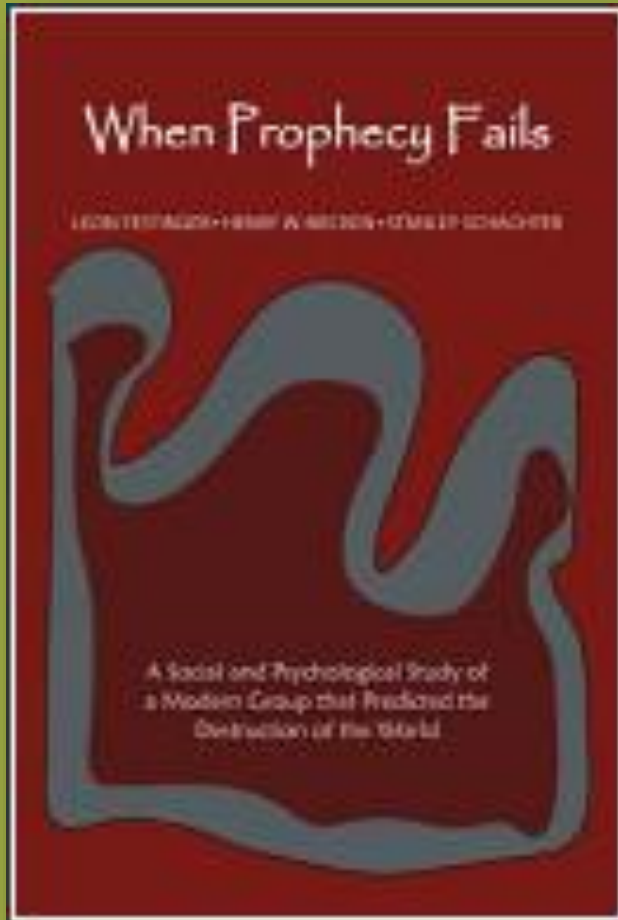

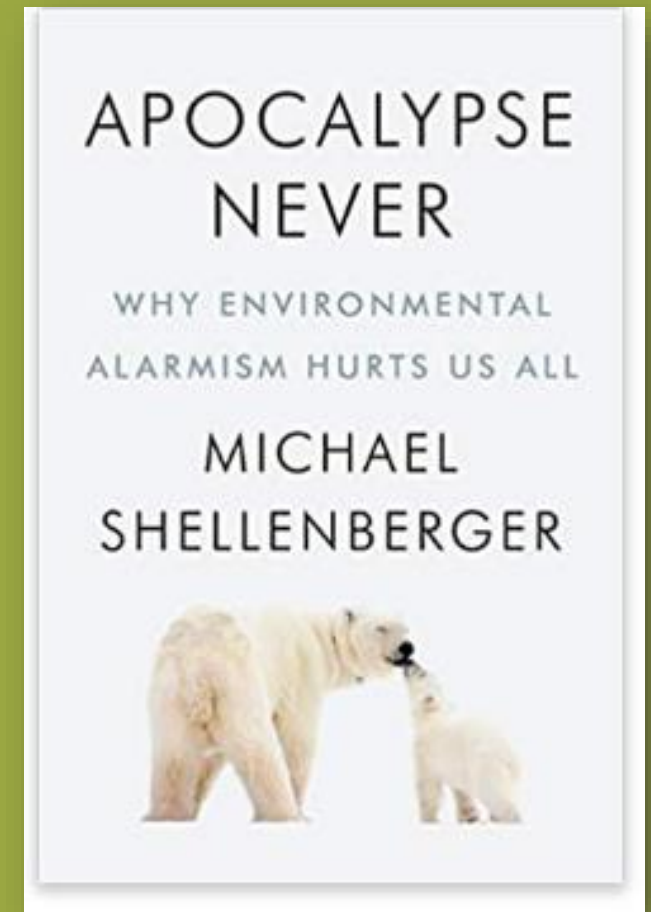

## Red Flags of Investing Fraud



**We would all like to find a great investment that guarantees financial security, but unfortunately some offers are just too good to be true.**

**If an investment you're interested in sounds like any of the ones below, STOP! The investment might be a scam.**

### **GUARANTEED HIGH RETURNS - NO RISK!**

There is no such thing! No one can offer you a guarantee – all investing involves some level of risk. Usually, the higher the returns, the higher the risk. Do your homework - research advertised investment opportunities to lessen the risk of falling victim to a scam.

### **OFFSHORE INVESTMENT – TAX FREE!**

You can sometimes defer paying taxes, but you can't avoid them. This type of deal is often pitched as a secret, and for reasons you might not expect. By asking you to keep the deal to yourself, scam artists know you won't have to answer hard questions from family, friends or financial advisers who might see through the scam. If you are persuaded to send your money overseas, it may be difficult, if not impossible to get back if something goes wrong.

### **GREAT INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITY – YOUR FRIENDS CAN'T BE WRONG!**

Yes they can! Many investment fraud victims are introduced to the scam by family, friends or co-workers. This approach relies on the trust you place in your friends and the fear of missing out on a "too good to be true" opportunity. Scam artists target religious, ethnic, or close-knit groups by working their way into organizations and befriending members in order to rip them off. This is often referred to as "affinity fraud". Always check out any individual or company offering you an investment opportunity.

### **INSIDER TIPS - PROFIT LIKE THE EXPERTS!**

These scams are pitched as opportunities known only to a select few who are said to be making a lot of money. The scam artist convinces you that he or she has access to this inside information that the general public does not have. You might be invited to a seminar where salespeople make misleading claims about a secret or exclusive technique for building wealth. Look carefully at what exactly is being offered and conduct a background check with the ASC to find out if there has been any disciplinary action or enforcement action taken against the company and/or individual, and if they are registered.

### **DON'T MISS THIS OPPORTUNITY - GET IN NOW!**

Scam artists use this tactic to pressure you into making a quick decision and try to exploit your fear of missing out on a valuable opportunity. Take the time you need to research any investment opportunity and get independent third-party advice.
