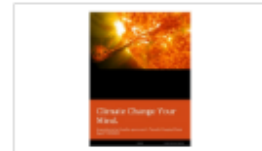

Thanks to generous donors, last year we were able to do two in-person events.

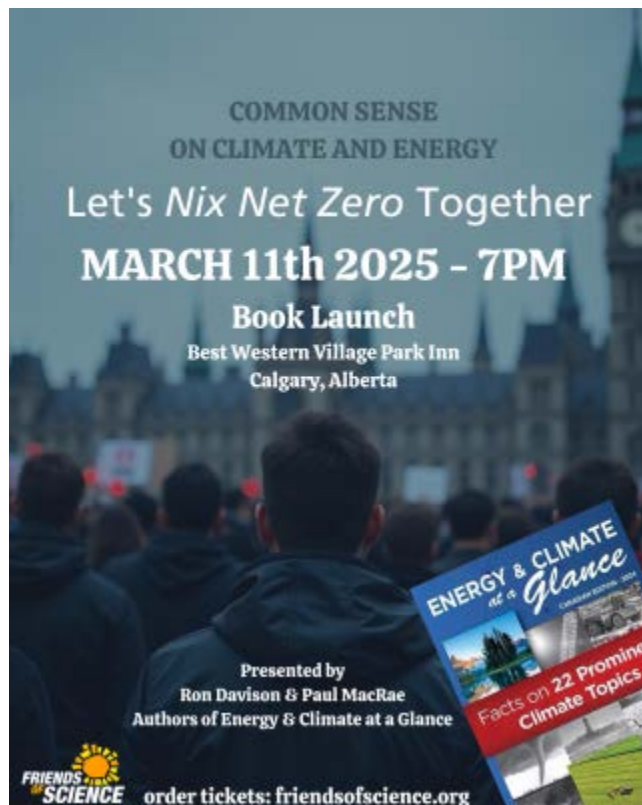

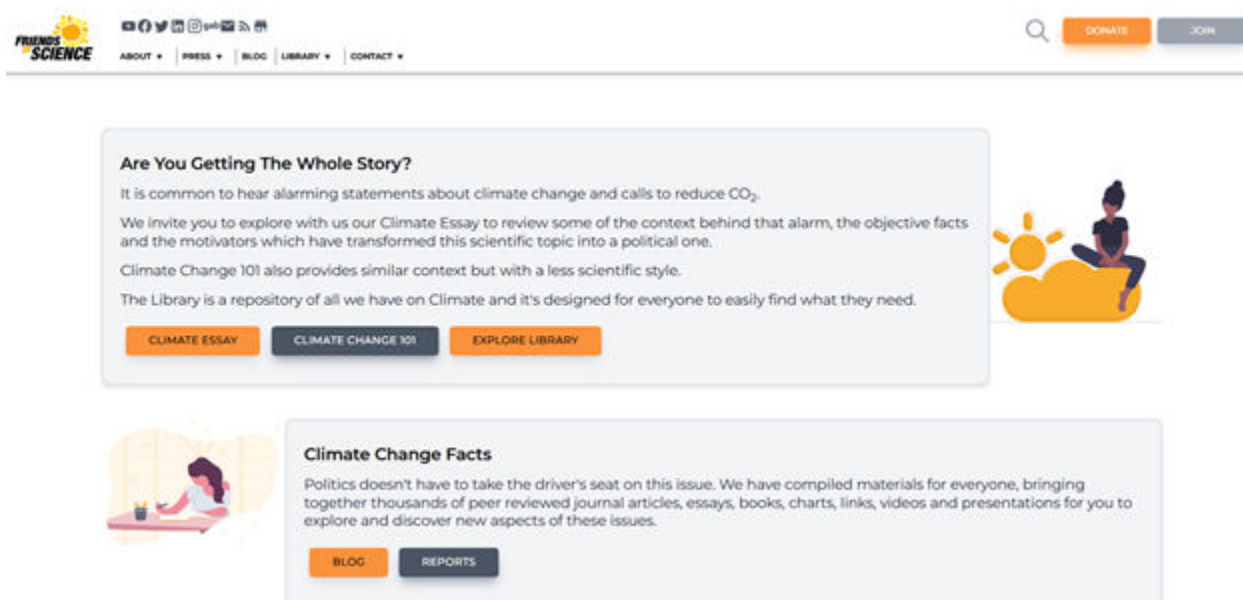

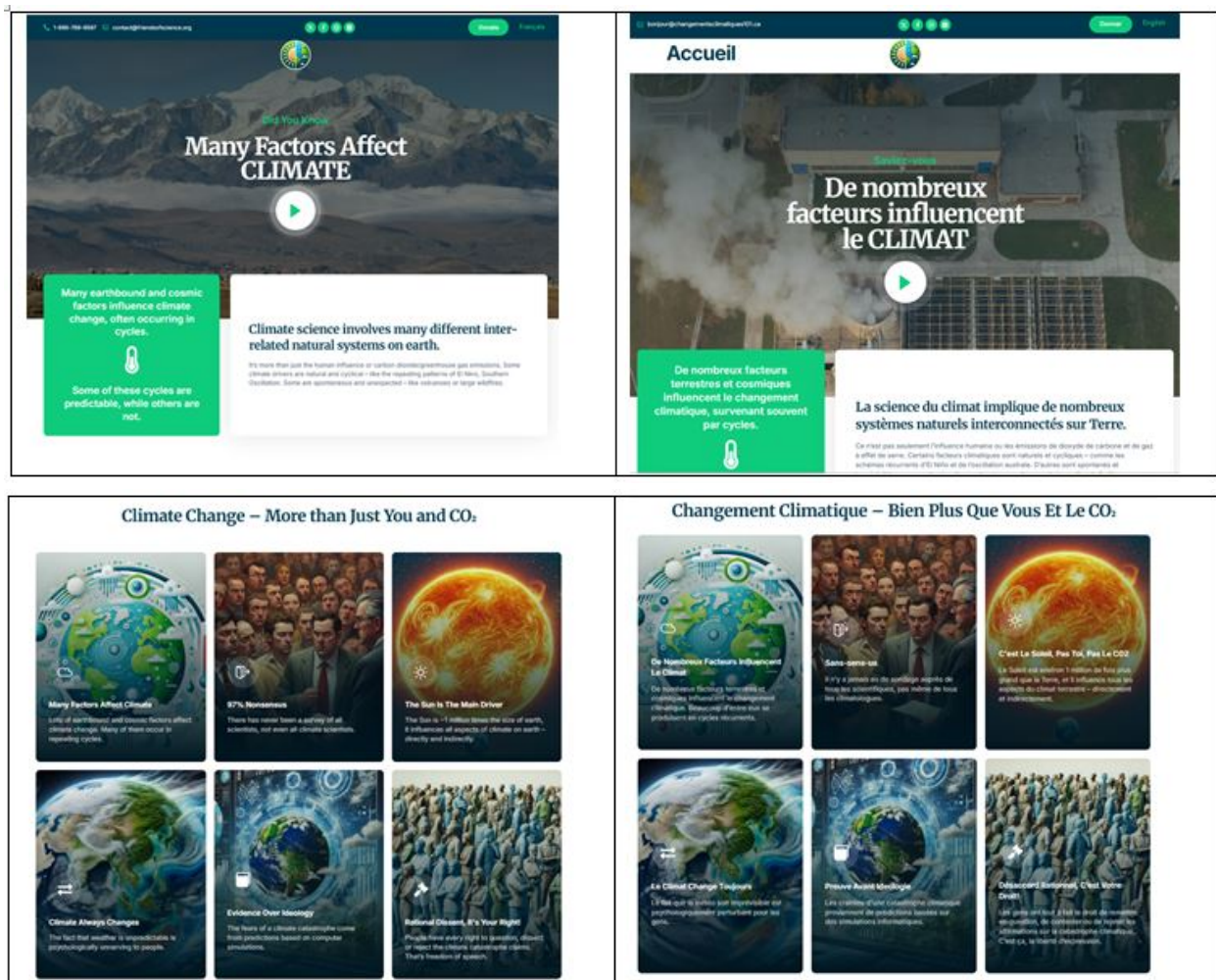


Refreshed and Refreshing – ClimateChange101.ca / ChangementsClimatique101.ca
